# Screenshots/ Screen Capture- all or part of screen



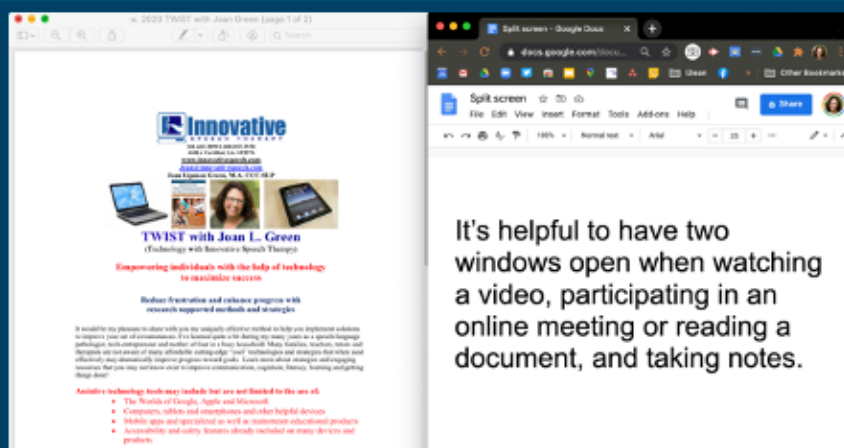
**Mac-** Press and hold Shift, Command and then 4 for entire screen or 3 for part of the screen.

**PC-** Press the Start key, type "snipping tool" and press Enter.

**iOS-** Press the side button and volume-up (or home) button at the same time.

**Android-** Hold the volume down button with the power button for 2 seconds.
