7:15pm III. Treasurer Update:

- 2021-22 Budget Proposal has been approved by the board and posted on the website for the past month. Our budget has been affected by Covid. The largest expenses are for teacher grants and awards. There are fixed costs like dues to VA and National PTA, insurance and the Post Office box. We have \$11,000 in the reserves right now and are proposing to spend approximately \$7,000 from those reserves this year. Ally Baldassari moved to approve the budget, seconded by Heather Scharre. Motion approved by a majority with no one opposed and Rich Hem abstaining.
- Sept Financial Statement
- Audit Proposal The Audit committee found that the treasurer did a good job keeping track of expenses and had excellent documentation of expenses. The recommendations were to use the track register to keep track of the checks. We recommended getting a debit card to help process reimbursements as SEPTA is county-wide PTA it is difficult to be in physical contact for reimbursements. The committee also recommends SEPTA establish protocols and safeguards to ensure no misuse of the debit card. Motion to approve the Audit committee report was approved by a majority with no one opposed and Rich Hem abstaining.
